## ABOUT PUNJABI UNIVERSITY

Punjabi University, Patiala, the second University in the world to be named after a language, was established by the Punjab Assembly under the Punjab Act No. 35 of 1961 in the erstwhile princely state of Patiala, with the main objective of furthering the cause of the Punjabi language. Housing over 70 teaching and research departments, spread over 600 acres of land, the beautiful campus boasts of 1500+ teachers imparting education to 14000+ students in a multi-faceted, multipronged and multi-faculty environment. Punjabi University has been untiringly fulfilling educational requirements all over Punjab through more than 270 affiliated colleges, 9 neighbourhood campuses, 14 constituent colleges and 6 regional centres. NAAC has awarded the University a 'Five Star' grade in the first cycle (2002-07) and 'A' grade in the second (2008-13) and third (2016-21) cycles. The University's performance in sports has been equally unmatched with the distinction of having won the Maulana Abul Kalam Azad (MAKA) Trophy, which is awarded by the Government of India for promoting competitive sports at the University level, 10 times (6 consecutive times). Most recently, EW India Government University Rankings 2020, has placed Punjabi University at the first position at the State level and at the 18th position in the National ranking list of 150 State Universities of India

## **ABOUT DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY**

The Department of Psychology was established in 1987, which marked the Silver Jubilee year of the University. The strength of the Department lies in its dedicated and highly qualified staff comprising of 4 Professors, 5 Associate Professors, 2 Assistant Professors, 3 Senior Technical Assistants and other Supporting Staff. Currently, the Department is running a M.A. course in Psychology along with 2 Post-Graduate Diplomas (P.G. Diploma in Counselling Psychology & P.G. Diploma in Child Development and Counselling) and a Ph.D. programme. While the thrust area of the department is Counselling Psychology, other specialization areas of the faculty include Clinical Psychology, Personality, Creativity, Organizational Behaviour, Experimental Psychology, Cognitive Psychology, Social Psychology, Sports Psychology, Forensic Psychology, Cyber Psychology, etc. The Department consists of 3 laboratories, namely, the Experimental lab, Testing lab and Biofeedback lab, which are well-equipped with psychological tests and instruments. Research activities are further facilitated through a Nodal-Computer laboratory as well. The department continuously endeavours to achieve academic excellence in Teaching, Research and Counselling.

## ABOUT PATIALA (PUNJAB)

Patiala, the 4<sup>th</sup> largest city in the state & the administrative capital of Patiala district, is in North-Western India. Patiala, home town of Chief Minister, Maharaja Amarinder Singh Punjab, was constructed by Ala Singh, who founded the royal dynasty of Patiala State in 1763. Proposals for Workshop/Symposium should include one abstract of the Workshop/Symposium proposal and maximum of 5 abstracts of individual presentations in the Symposium. The abstract/symposium should be typed in MS Word file format & sent to the Conference Director at <u>iaap2021pbi@gmail.com</u>

## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

- 1. Size of the Abstract should not exceed 250 words.
- 2. All submissions must be original and should not have been previously accepted for publication in any other journal, or presented in any other conference.
- 3. The abstract should describe the background, purpose, method, results (if any), and unique contributions of the research.

- 4. Indicate the form of presentation as ORAL or <u>A</u>POSTER
- Use 12-point Times New Roman Font for the text with single line spacing without indentations and 1 Inch margin throughout.
- 6. Include details of the author and all co-authors. The details of authors should include Name, Organization to which affiliate, email address and phone number.
- 7. It may be noted that the abstract received after due date will not be included in Souvenir/Book of Abstracts.
- 8. There will be a single presenter for each presentation and the certificate for presentation of the paper will be issued to that presenter only.
